### A FIRM TREE HAS BEEN PLANTED

Throughout the past 22 years, Orphan Helpers' work has been rooted in serving vulnerable youth in Central America. The ministry began in orphanages and then expanded to juvenile detention centers. Today, 95% of our work is focused on serving incarcerated youth behind bars and released youth reentering society. We believe that every youth has a future worth fighting for. The Gospel of Jesus is our core message. He is the vine. We are the branches. The fruitfulness of our work flows from being attached to Him, and 2022 has been a fruitful year.

# ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN 2022

388 incarcerated youth participated in Success Academies behind bars. *See photo* ①.

133 youth followed Christ's example and were baptized behind bars. See photo 2.

released youth in Honduras and El Salvador were mentored & guided by our Success Coaches during reentry back to society. See photo 3.

103 released youth participated in our "Work for Success" program that provides assistance as they work towards their goals in education & entrepreneurship.

# BRANCHING OUT IN CENTRAL AMERICA

Orphan Helpers sends teams of facilitators behind bars full-time, bringing education, hope and the message of the Gospel to incarcerated youth. Government officials in Central America have recognized the quality and effectiveness of our work and doors are opening for us to branch out, impacting even more youth for the Kingdom of God! In 2023, we look forward to three key growth opportunities.

#### 1. EXPANSION IN GUATEMALA

In January of 2023, Orphan Helpers will launch the first Success Academy class in Guatemala at a juvenile detention center for girls. Orphan Helpers started the Success Academy in 2016 in El Salvador and Honduras. Since that time, Orphan Helpers' facilitators have led more than 1,000 incarcerated youth through the program, preparing young men and women to flourish in their homes and communities upon release.

# 2. INCREASE IN INCARCERATED YOUTH IN EL SALVADOR

The total population of juvenile detention centers has soared from 200 to over 1,500 youth in the past year.

These mass arrests are happening as the Salvadoran government cracks down on crime and violence. Orphan Helpers is responding to the demand of the current crisis by expanding efforts to reach more young people for Christ inside the detention centers. See photo 3.

#### 3. GROWTH IN AFTERCARE WORK

The team of Success Coaches at
Orphan Helpers is working with
more and more young men and
women leaving the detention centers
and reentering society. Orphan
Helpers expanded the number of
Success Coaches from four to eight
positions last year to handle the
increased caseloads. In the year
ahead, Success Coaches will advance
the work to:

- Support youth in their educational and entrepreneurial pursuits.


